

CITY IN THE CENTER REGION OF PORTUGAL WITH HIGHEST CONCENTRATION OF POPULATION

Coimbra has the highest concentration of population in the center region of Portugal, with 140.816 inhabitants, representing over 30% of NUT III. Compared to other cities in the region, Coimbra has a larger population: 70% more than Aveiro and 10% more than Leiria. [5]

HIGHEST PER CAPITA PURCHASING POWER IN THE REGION

The average salary in Coimbra is $\in 1.182$, slightly below the national average ($\in 1.206$), in a context where the cost of living is favourable [4]. The per capita purchasing power is the highest in the center region of Portugal, and the real estate market offers competitive values (average cost per square meter of $\in 1.839$ vs. the national average of $\in 2.582$), ensuring high standards of quality of life. GREEN SPACES AND MOBILITY


Coimbra is a "15-minute city", crossed by the Mondego river with inviting banks for walks and sports, a mild climate, 180 hectares of green spaces, sidewalks and bike paths that provide ways to explore the city on foot or by bicycle. With a strong focus on sustainability, quality of life, and well-being, Coimbra pioneered the creation of a rapid electric transport network (Portugal's 1st Bus Rapid Transit), impacting decarbonization of mobility in the center region of Portugal.

CULTURE AND HERITAGE



A cosmopolitan city, Coimbra was the first capital of the kingdom with significant cultural heritage. With a strong connection to gastronomy, tourism, sports, and culture, it hosts various national and international events. The University of Coimbra – Alta and Sofia was classified as a UNESCO World Heritage site in 2013.


